Academics and Training

- With the sudden lockdown and school closure teachers had to work all the more hard as classes were to be conducted online.
- From 1st April Mater Dei commenced online classes on Zoom. Teachers gradually got into the system of online classes with 85 per cent of students attending. Teachers also took great care while taking online classes to ensure the safety of the students. They tried their best to keep up to the standards of the school.
- From 17th April 2020, in keeping with the directives of the MHRD to reduce screen time for children, Mater Dei re-worked itsTime Table to ensure that the children have adequate rest breaks and are not having too much screen time.
- From 1st July 2020 we shifted to Microsoft Teams. The staff underwent numerous trainings in order to familiarise themselves with this platform.
- Teachers made lot of effort to make their classes innovative and enriching even though initially they were not familiar with all the tools available online:
- PowerPoint presentations, videos and write ups were made and presented by the students-role reversal.
- Teachers too used PowerPoint presentations and videos to reinforce concepts.
- Poetry writing, slogan writing, slogan writing, skit, brainstorming, quiz, vocabulary building exercises, learning games,
- Puppets, sharing fun facts and hands on experience were used.

Kitchen turned into a lab to learn so many skills- kneading chopping, grating, grinding, tossing, baking, handling the cooking equipment. It developed confidence in the students and gave them an opportunity to show their creativity at home.
